

Prudential RideLondon-Surrey Logistics



Bike Transport:

We are working with Chapeau Events to provide return bike transfer from Manchester to London. The provisional details are as follows: -

- Bikes will need to be dropped off at a location in Cheshire
- They will then be transported to London ready for your collection on Saturday 3rd August
- The collection point will be near to the ExCel Centre where all riders must register to receive their rider numbers
- Following the ride on Sunday 4th August, you will drop off your bike at an agreed location (as near to the finish as logistically possible).
- Bikes will then be transported back to Manchester; ready for your collection

There will be a fee of £20* to use this service and we hope it will considerably increase the ease of everyone's journeys to and from Manchester.

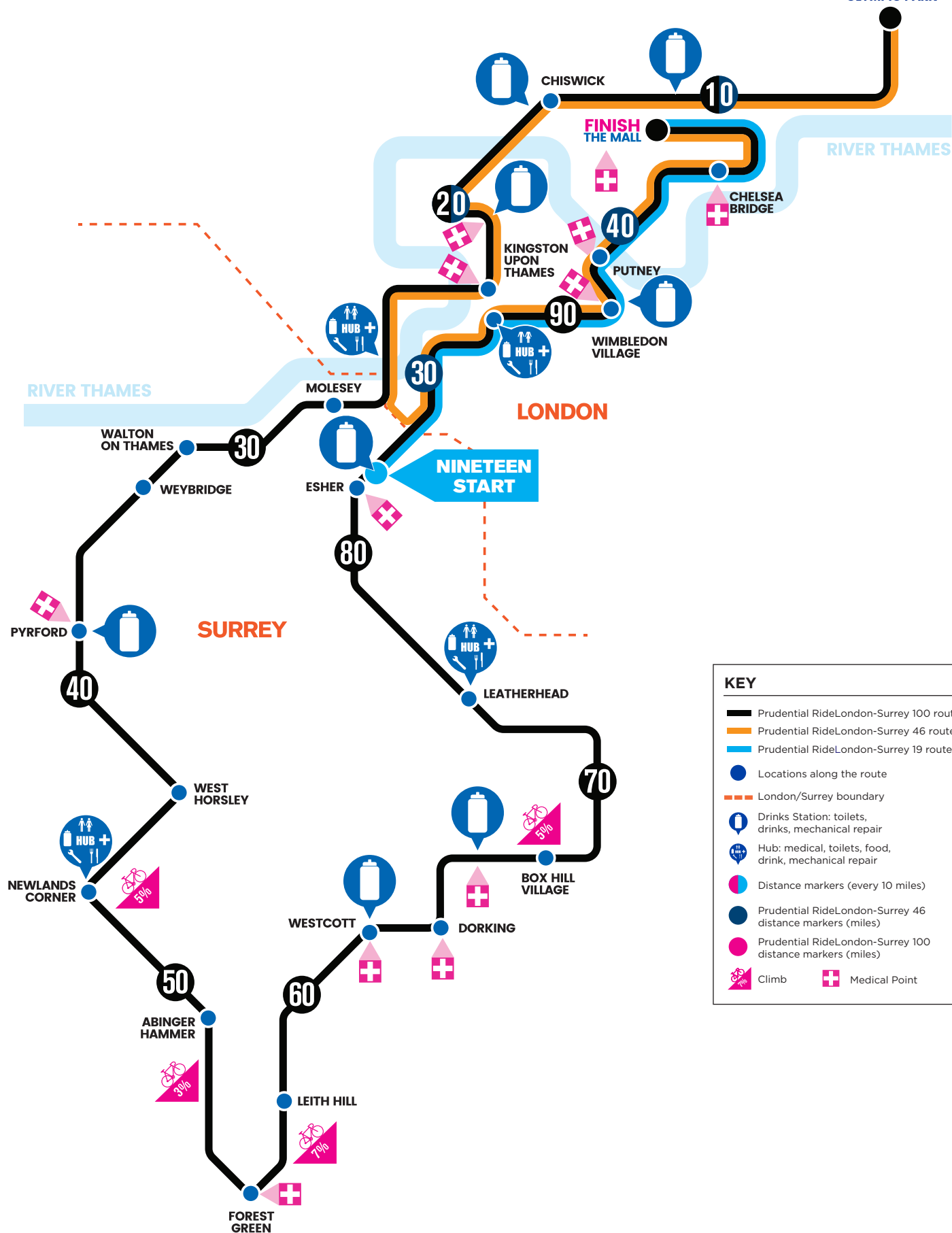
Accommodation:

- We advise that all Prudential RideLondon-Surrey participants book accommodation for the ride weekend ASAP. Prices are increasing, and places are selling out fast.
- For ease, the most popular location for hotels is the Docklands in East London. The area around Wapping, Limehouse and Canary Wharf is good because it's close enough to the start (Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park) that you can either ride there or get on the DLR.
- Once the ride is over, you can get the Thames Clipper with your bike (although if you're using our transport service this might not be required) back from Embankment to the Docklands (Canary Wharf is the disembark point). Once back in East London you will be able to get out of the city more easily as the roads on this side of London are opened earlier. Being based in East London will also make it easier to go to the Excel Centre to collect your rider numbers.
- PLEASE NOTE - Participants in the 46-mile event in particular need to take road closures into account as they will be in place before the 46 event begins. Check out the RideLondon [Info Hub](#) for detailed advice on road closures.
- Previous Prevent Breast Cancer riders have either stayed: -
 - Near to the start – Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park –depending on who you are travelling with, you will need to return to collect your luggage after the ride
 - Near to the finish – Green Park –you will have further to cycle to get to the start and depending on your start time road closures may already be in place
