

September Sportive: BIKE or HIKE Terms and Conditions



1. This agreement is between Prevent Breast Cancer and you and relates to your proposed participation in the September Sportive: BIKE or HIKE 2021 (referred to as 'the event')
2. This agreement will come into force when Prevent Breast Cancer has accepted your registration to take part in the event.
3. Prevent Breast Cancer reserves the right not to accept your application for registration, in which case Prevent Breast Cancer will return your registration entry fee.
4. The purpose of this agreement is:
 - 4.1 to enable you to take part in the event to support Prevent Breast Cancer; and
 - 4.2 to set out your obligations and Prevent Breast Cancer's obligations in relation to the event.
5. The event is organised by Prevent Breast Cancer and will be provided by Chapeau Events Ltd on behalf of the Charity
6. If you are selected to take part in the event (in accordance with clauses 8) you will have a direct contract with Prevent Breast Cancer.
7. All enquiries and requests for information before departure will be handled by Prevent Breast Cancer are available on our website. You acknowledge that you will be contacted by email, phone, SMS and post in relation to the specific event you have registered for, ensuring Prevent Breast Cancer can deliver the necessary administration and communication required to complete your successful participation in the event.
8. To be eligible for the event you must:
 - 8.1 complete the registration form and return it to Prevent Breast Cancer with a non-refundable entry fee of £26 for the BIKE, £15 for the HIKE and £5 for HIKE CHILD. payable to Prevent Breast Cancer
 - 8.2 be over 16 at the time of booking for the BIKE, unless otherwise agreed by Prevent Breast Cancer. Children aged 16-17 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
 - 8.3 children under 16 are welcome to take part in the HIKE but must be accompanied by a responsible parent or guardian
9. You will only be entitled to take part in the event if you undertake or agree with the following:
 - 9.1 Prevent Breast Cancer receives from you the initial sum specified on the registration form; and
 - 9.2 The event which you are registering for is physically challenging and may pose a risk of discomfort, illness, injury, and even death. You need to be satisfied that you are physically capable of doing the event without undue risk to your health or life. We do not conduct health or fitness checks on entrants and the responsibility for your ability to participate in the event is with you as the participant.
 - 9.3 Prevent Breast Cancer (acting reasonably) is satisfied that your participation in the event is not likely to have a detrimental effect on the morale of the participants as a whole so as to make it likely that other participants will fail to complete the event. You acknowledge you are fully responsible for your participation in the event and Prevent Breast Cancer does not accept responsibility or liability for any loss or damage arising from the event.

10. Prevent Breast Cancer will not provide alcohol during any stage of the event. It will be the responsibility of the individual participant to be legally fit to take part in all stages of the event. Should an accident occur and any participant be found to have exceeded legal alcohol limits, the charity's liability insurance will be invalid for that individual and the contract will be null and void.

11. The Highway Code must be obeyed and the wearing of a cycle helmet during the cycle challenge is compulsory at all times. Cyclists must ensure their bikes are roadworthy and serviced. Prevent Breast Cancer will not be liable for personal injury, death, damage to property or other loss whether arising from accident, cancellation, delay or any other matter beyond their control.

12. The Highway code must also be obeyed by those taking part in the walking event and appropriate clothing and footwear for all potential weather conditions must be worn. Prevent Breast Cancer will not be liable for personal injury, death, damage to property or other loss whether arising from accident, cancellation, delay or any other matter beyond their control.

13. Dogs can join the HIKE but Prevent Breast Cancer will not be liable for their safety whether arising from accident or any other matter beyond their control.

13. If you have to withdraw prior to the event, you must notify Prevent Breast Cancer immediately. This means we may be able to re-allocate your place to someone else. Any money raised will be retained as a donation towards Prevent Breast Cancer's work. If you wish to refund your donors in this instance, you must ask your individual donors to make a written request to us, as they will be refunded directly.

14. Prevent Breast Cancer will use all reasonable endeavours to ensure that the event takes place so far as reasonably possible in accordance with the information provided. However, Prevent Breast Cancer may make such alterations to the arrangements as they may reasonably require.

15. You acknowledge that any photography or film footage taken as part of your participation in the event can be used for promotional and marketing purposes for this specific event and any future Prevent Breast Cancer events activity.

16. If you choose not to participate in the event or if you do not become eligible to take part in the event or if Prevent Breast Cancer prevents you from doing so, all sums collected or pledged will still be payable to the charity; the entry fee is not refundable in any other circumstances.

17. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between Prevent Breast Cancer and you relating to the event and supersedes all other prior representations, agreements, or arrangements whether written or oral, express or implied relating to the event.

18. This agreement is governed by English law and you and we irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

19. By completing the online registration form to take part in the event, you agree to be bound by these conditions.
